#### How the entrance works:

Admission to the museum is regulated by a traffic light that is placed on the upper entrance platform of the museum.

A maximum of 5 visitors may stay in the waiting area on the platform.

Before you go up the stairs to the platform, please make sure that there are no more than 5 people. Otherwise, please wait below in front of the garden gate.

# On the platform:

When the traffic light is green, please enter individually or in pairs. If you are part of a group please ask someone at the museum reception whether entry as a group is currently possible.

When the traffic light is red, please wait! The reception area is occupied or the maximum number of visitors is in the museum.

Please keep the distance of 1.5 m to the next visitor in the line (markings on the floor).

Please wear your everyday mask.

### In the museum:

Please fill out the contact form correctly.

A maximum of 15 visitors may stay in the in the Weissenhof museum.

The distance requirement of at least 1.5 m applies inside the museum.

It is mandatory to wear an everyday mask.

There is a strict one-way traffic in the museum.

## How the exit works:

The exit is controlled by a walkie-talkie which you will find at the end of your tour in the "laundry room". Please press the bell-button on the walkie-talkie, our colleague will inform you via the loudspeaker whether the reception area is free and you can come back through the garden.
