

Welcome!

The Weissenhof Museum has reopened on May 19th, 2020.

For now, the following opening times apply:

Tue - Sat	12pm to 5pm
Sun, public holidays	12pm to 6pm
Mon	closed

A maximum of 10 visitors may stay in the Weissenhof Museum.

Visitors can only be let in and out single or in pairs. Our entrance situation is very narrow.

Please be patient and expect waiting periods (entrance depends on the queue, exit about 10 minutes).

The distance requirement of at least 1.5 meters applies inside the whole museum.

It is mandatory to wear an everyday mask. If necessary, you can buy masks at the reception (1 €).

How the entrance works:

Please keep a distance from 1.5 meters to the next visitor in the queue.

As soon as you are in the first place, please press the bell-button on the walkie-talkie (see picture page 4).

Our colleague will inform you via the loudspeaker and will pick you up as soon as the entrance area is free.

When the walkie-talkie does not work, please call +49 711-25 79 187.

At the reception you will buy your entrance ticket: 5 €/2 € reduced for pupils, students etc.

Put your bag into the lockers. This is an obligation, you need 1 € coin as a deposit.

Disinfectant is available at the entrance and in the museum.

How the tour works:

You will start the tour through the museum along the arrows. There is strict one-way traffic in the staircases. In the other areas, please keep the distance of 1.5 meters and be considerate of the other visitors.

The tour guides from the entrance ① through the left half of the house (exhibition on the Weissenhof Estate ②) from the bottom up ④. Over the rooftop ⑤ you will reach the right half of the house (original situation from 1927). In this part the tour guides from top to bottom ⑥ - ⑩.

How the exit works:

After finishing your tour in the laundry ⑩, get in touch with us again by walkie-talkie.

You will find the walkie-talkie on the table. Please press the bell-button on the walkie-talkie (see picture page 4).

Our colleague will inform you via the loudspeaker and will pick you up as soon as the entrance area is free.

You will find books on the table that you can buy on the reception. There you will find the same copies again.

If the weather is fine, you can also wait in the garden. Please be patient until we can pick you up.
